



## **Registration and Access Guide for O'Reilly for Higher Education**


O'Reilly for Higher Education offers different authentication methods on the platform for the end users. Please talk to your local library for more information if needed.

This guide is designed to detail the process of accessing and registering O'Reilly via **Institutional email**. Please find the details below:


#### 1. Easy access with email address

Either on campus or from the comfort of your home, click on the O'Reilly login link: <u>https://www.oreilly.com/library/view/temporary-access/</u>, this link may already be available in the resource listing on your library portal, in your library catalog, or in your institution's discovery service.


After accessing the service through the indicated URL, the following modal window will be displayed. First check **"Select your institution"** if your institution is providing a specific login link. If not, you must select the option **"Institution not listed"?** 




On the next screen, you will be prompted to enter your institutional email address, after doing so click "Let's Go", this will grant you immediate access to O'Reilly for Higher Education.



**Note:** If for any reason you see a message similar to "*This email is not associated with an academic account*", we recommend that you forward this warning to our Training & Consulting team at training@proquest.com. It is important to consider only institutional addresses, i.e., omit personal or commercial emails.
